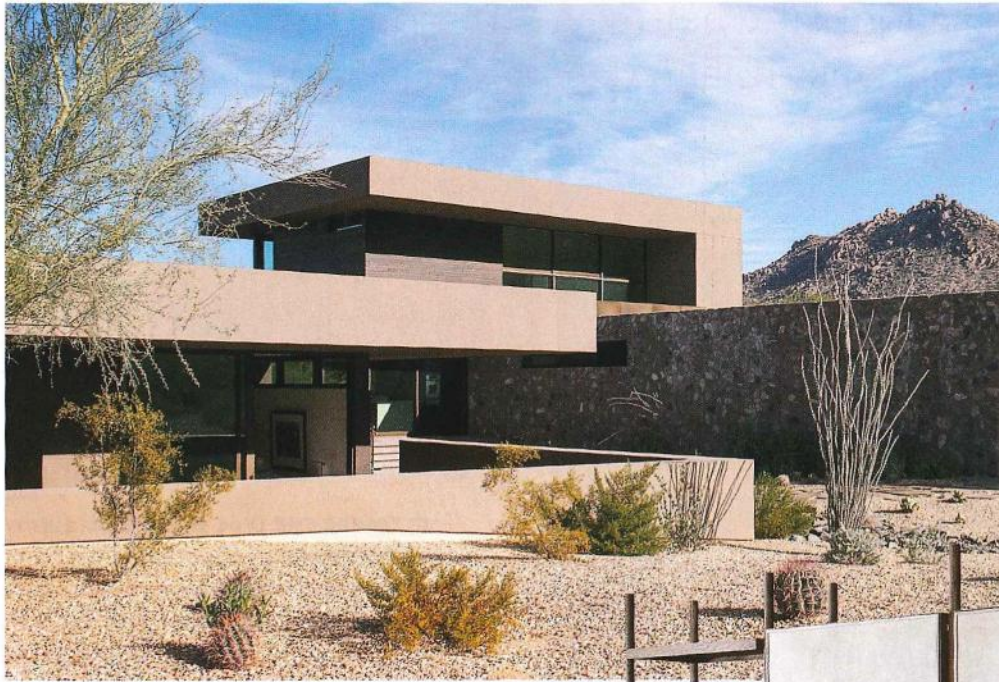

# Desert Blooms

Cult designers Marmol Radziner bring California modernism to their line of furniture and homewares for McGuire.

**PICTURE BIG, BOX-SHAPED** structures cantilevered over desert vistas, and you'll get a sense of how architecture firm Marmol Radziner does West Coast cool. The company, which has offices in Los Angeles and San Francisco, has designed modernist homes up and down the California coastline, most outfitted with its no-frills custom furniture. For its Canyon collection for McGuire, which includes furniture, fabrics, and serveware, the aim was to celebrate the state's abundant nature. "We like when our architecture gets overgrown by the landscape surrounding it," says principal Ron Radziner. Natural materials such as oak and bronze feature prominently, with touches of rawhide or rattan. "It allows for something modern," Radziner says, "but a bit softer." *mcguire furniture.com; 800-592-2537. —J.H.*
